Surrounded by vineyards, Esslingen is located on the Neckar River. It is only 20 kilometers away from Stuttgart, the capital of Baden-Wuerttemberg (12 minutes by train from Esslingen). Esslingen's historic old town with its numerous half-timbered houses, bars, restaurants as well as cultural events make an ideal location for a successful semester abroad. There are good connections to the Black Forest, Munich, France and Switzerland. The story of Esslingen goes back over 1200 years. It is an attractive location for industry and economy.

Frequently Asked Questions

Passports should be valid for at least six months after end of stay in Germany.

Guests from EU countries and Switzerland do not need a visa.
 They just need to bring their valid passport or personal identification card.

Visa and Identification Requirements

- Some nationalities (e.g. USA, Japan, South Korea) can travel to Germany without a visa. A residence permit has to be applied for after arrival.
- Guests from Mexico, Argentina, China and Singapore have to apply for a visa before arrival.
